#### **Applicant Criteria:**

Jewish Studies Minor, minimum of 3.0 GPA

#### **Application Requirements:**

In order to be eligible for the Finifter Scholarship, you will need to submit the following:

1. Application form;
2. Essay describing what you hope to get out of the course you will take that counts for the JS minor;
  - a. What the course is, and when you plan to take it;
  - b. Discuss why you are interested in the course, and your interest in the JS minor;
  - c. Please include information concerning your financial need for this scholarship; and
3. Official MSU transcript (<https://reg.msu.edu/Transcripts/>) sent directly to the Director.

\*Please contact Director Professor Aronoff if you have extenuating circumstances that require an extension for the deadline and there is a possibility, that if there are available funds, that you can apply late.

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**INSTRUCTIONS:** Please be sure to provide all the information requested above and below; only completed applications will be considered. This form is meant to be completed electronically; that is, simply use the TAB key or mouse to move from one field to the next. When you've provided the information requested, sign the form. Deadlines for submission of applications are given above.
