Eric and Deborah Abramson Scholarship **for Holocaust Studies in Europe, Israel, or the U.S.**

Scholarships of \$1,000-\$2,000 for research or internships focused on antisemitism or the Holocaust.

Administered by the Michigan State University
Michael and Elaine Serling Institute for Jewish Studies and Modern Israel

Application criteria and expectations:

Applicants must have already been accepted by an organization to participate in an internship for a period of six weeks or more unless combined with a Study Abroad Program, in which case the internship period may be for a period of four weeks or more. Internships will be approved by the Director of The Institute.

After the trip - all recipients must also submit a brief written statement and thank you letter addressed to the donors, Eric and Deborah Abramson, on their experiences studying in Israel within 30 days of their return. These statements will help promote the Abramson Scholarship and study abroad in Israel programs at MSU.

Application requirements:

In order to be eligible for the Abramson Scholarship, you will need to submit the following:

- 1) An application form;
 - 2) Official MSU transcript (<https://reg.msu.edu/Transcripts/>) sent directly to the Director;
 - 3) A 300–500-word essay describing your internship in Israel and what you hope to get out of it that will impact you academically, professionally and personally; and
 - 4) A detailed budget.
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INSTRUCTIONS: Please be sure to provide all the information requested below; only completed applications will be considered. This form is meant to be completed electronically; that is, simply use the TAB key or mouse to move from one field to the next. When you've provided the information requested, sign the form. Deadlines for submission of applications are given above. The scholarship will first be applied toward any unpaid tuition or other funds owed to the University or may be subtracted from any federal financial aid/loan funds. Any remaining funds will be disbursed to you after the scholarship form has been processed via whatever method you have set up in your student account (student.msu.edu). Please seek advice from your Office of Financial Aid counselor if you have any questions.

Finally, I understand that if I withdraw from study abroad in Israel (either voluntarily or involuntarily, e.g., if I am suspended from the program) that I will need to reimburse the university the full scholarship. This will not apply to a situation where, due to safety and security considerations, the program is suspended or shortened.
