Jewish Studies Minors are encouraged to apply



Applicant requirements and guidelines:

- » Scholarship recipients must be undergraduate students minoring in Jewish Studies.
- » Preference will be given to Jewish Studies minors demonstrating financial need.
- » The scholarship is to cover in-state tuition for one Jewish Studies course (\$2,500 for a 5-credit course, \$2,000 for a 4-credit course, \$1,500 for a 3-credit course, or \$500 for 1-credit course).
- » Write an essay (send in Word Doc) explaining what you learned in the class, how it influenced you academically, professionally, and/or personally and please describe financial need.
- » Provide a recommendation from the faculty teaching the course sent directly to Dr. Yael Aronoff and Ariana Mentzel.
- » Provide an official transcript sent via the Registrar's Office to Dr. Yael Aronoff.
- » The above required materials are due by Friday, December 6th, 2024, for the Fall Semester.
